These numbers are just what we have done recently. The key thing is that every boat is built to the same standard for fairness. The most important measurements that should match for everyone are the width, length and sail area. We also notched in a bit of lathe as a fixed rudder at the stern of the boat.

Run the races in a pair of 10' eavestrough sections in notched sawhorses. Scouts (or Cubs) blow into the sails to make them go.
